

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Born to be wild



Many people dream about having their own motorhome and driving off into the sunset, ready to visit remote places and live a life full of exciting off grid adventures! Wild camping is undoubtedly a wonderful experience, but often means no access to waste disposal, running water or electricity, so there are a few things you need to be aware of before you head off.

The Golden Rules:

Perform a quick check of your vehicle and make sure you know how to behave on the road, especially when you're driving to unfamiliar locations where the terrain may be challenging. Pack all your motorhome essentials to ensure you'll camp in comfortable conditions and always follow the best practices of wild camping.

Generally, wild camping without the landowner's permission is illegal in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. However, many landowners will be happy to allow campers, as long you respect the land. Wild camping in Scotland isn't prohibited, so that means you can technically pitch up wherever you like – including the country's incredible National Parks. You can find more information and details about how to ask permission to camp at www.wandering-bird.com.

Treat the area you are camping on with respect and don't cause damage to field crops or nearby trees.

Be as discreet as possible and follow the rules of 'Leave No Trace' and don't litter.

Avoid building a campfire unless you find a designated spot. Many areas have a no fires rule so do check carefully. If you do find a safe area, make sure the fire is fully cold before you leave.

You'll need to empty the wastewater tank at some point. Best practice is to only empty it at campsite disposal areas – some campsites will allow you to use their disposal areas for a small fee if you're not staying with them. Similarly, the toilet cassette containing your septic/waste and water needs to be disposed

of carefully and this should only be emptied in designated disposal areas at campsites. If this is not an option, emptying it into a public toilet is the next best option. Do not empty it all at once as this will risk blocking the toilet.

Don't overstay your welcome – usually three days in one spot is enough.

Glen Coe Mountain Resort

An area of outstanding natural beauty on Rannoch Moor offering stunning views of the iconic Buachaille Etive Mor.

If you fancy travelling a little further afield then there are plenty of beautiful places to wild camp in Europe that are within easy reach.

A great app for finding wild overnight parking spots in Europe or the UK is park4night.com. This site is FREE to join and there is both an app and a website. It lists many car parks and approved motorhome overnight stops, which is useful if you need something not too far off the main roads.



With the ever-present stresses of everyday life, mental health is front of mind for many of us – but did you know that studies have shown camping, in all it different forms, and outdoor enjoyment can actually improve your mental health and well-being?

Recent research, commissioned by The Camping and Caravanning Club, has revealed that there are a whole range of benefits to be found for campers. The study, which included a survey of nearly 11,000 campers and non-campers assessing attitudes towards the advantages of all types of camping, found 88% of those who feel motivated to go camping do it in order to take time out of everyday life and reduce stress. The research also revealed that campers reported higher levels of psychological well-being than non-campers.

In fact, a huge 93% of campers value camping for the benefits to their mental health and well-being. Campers were found to be both more interested in and more satisfied with life, have a stronger sense of belonging to a community, be more social and feel less stressed, and feel better able to manage their responsibilities in comparison to their non-camping counterparts.

Camping offers a combination of fresh air, exercise and connecting with nature, which are all known to have positive effects on our mental state. Camping provides a pathway for physical activity too, with 98% participating in outdoor activities while away, with walking named as the most popular activity.

Providing the perfect opportunity to create long-lasting memories and strengthen bonds between friends and family members, it's no surprise that camping has been found to increase happiness. A huge 97% of campers say this is their main motivator to go!

Camping has been shown to have lasting effects on happiness, with 48% of campers reporting feeling happiness almost every day, compared to 35% of non-campers. In fact, 44% of campers reported themselves to be flourishing (having optimal mental health) compared to just 31% of non-campers. This figure increases even further for those who camp more often, with frequent campers reporting better emotional, social and psychological well-being, which shows camping's effect on mental health shouldn't be underestimated.

It's clear that camping and outdoor enjoyment in all different forms have a wide array of benefits, adding up to a healthier and happier lifestyle, where you can appreciate nature and be active outdoors. So... where will you go for your next camping trip, and will you be taking a Swift with you?

Recipes For Campers and Caravanners with Rachel Green



Chef, author, TV presenter and food campaigner Rachel Green has teamed up with Swift to create a series of recipes which are ideal for hungry campers and caravanners. As a 14th generation farmer, Rachel is passionate about seasonal produce and has been part of many live cooking demonstrations and TV appearances - most notably for the late Queen.

You may have even spotted Rachel whipping up delectable dishes on the Swift Group's stand at the 2022 Motorhome and Caravan Show! With a wealth of experience cooking in all environments, from fields to beaches, and a love for a vast range of cuisines, Rachel utilises space-saving ingredients and equipment to create flavourful recipes that the whole family will love.

Serving four people, Rachel's Spiced Apricot, Lamb and Olive Tagine recipe was created inside the Swift Monza using the on board two-burner gas hob.



Ingredients

A good slug of rapeseed oil, for frying 500g lamb neck fillet or leg steaks, diced Salt & pepper

1 large red onion, sliced

1 red chilli, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, finely chopped

2 tbsp harissa paste

1 tsp cumin seeds

1 tsp ground ginger

½ a cinnamon stick

A small handful of coriander leaves,

250ml chicken stock

1 x 400g can chopped tomatoes

12 green olives, stoned

8 dried apricots, chopped

4 dried prunes, chopped

A good squeeze of runny honey

A squeeze of lemon juice

To serve

Greek yoghurt 1 x small tub pomegranate seeds Chopped coriander

Chopped pistachios (optional)

Spiced Apricot, Lamb & Olive Tagine

Method

- 1. Heat the oil in a casserole pan over a medium heat. Fry the lamb for 3 minutes until browned.
- Season with a little salt and pepper and then add the onion, chilli, garlic, harissa paste, spices, and two thirds of the chopped coriander (reserving the rest to serve) and mix to coat the meat well. Cook for a further 3 minutes.
- 3. Add the stock, chopped tomatoes, olives, dried fruit, honey, and lemon juice. Simmer on a low heat, partly covered, for approx. 45-50 minutes or until tender, stirring occasionally, adding a little more stock if it gets too thick. Taste and adjust the seasoning if necessary.
- 4. To serve, top with a little yoghurt and scatter over the pomegranate seeds, coriander, and pistachios (if using).

Here's my top tricks and tips for making the most of your on board storage space, while still creating the most flavoursome dishes.

I always recommend prepping your first meal before you leave – use leftover takeaway containers or Tupperware to bring along pre-prepared ingredients and you can create a delicious dish in no time when you arrive at your destination.

I never go away without my trusty spice box – it contains an array of my favourite spices which can be used to create a whole range of tasty recipes, from Turkish baked eggs to a fragrant curry.

If you're really short on space, just take along the items you know you'll use multiple times on your trip, and you can pick up fresh produce at your destination to complete your meals.

Rachel's Packing Essentials List

- Tinned pulses or beans these can be used in lots of different recipes and are great for vegetarian meals.
- Tinned tomatoes from soups, to stews, to shakshuka, they are the ultimate versatile ingredient.
- Flour with a million and one different uses, you could whip up easy flatbreads or pancakes for breakfast.
- Small, stackable containers ideal for taking along pre-prepared ingredients and storing leftovers.
- Pouches of ready cooked rice, and grains such as couscous and quinoa – perfect to quickly warm up to go alongside your main meal after a long day exploring.
- Coconut milk ideal for desserts, creamy curries, and Asian quick noodle soups, this is another versatile ingredient that has many uses.
- Jarred ingredients whether it's roasted red peppers, mushroom antipasti, or olives, these will save you time and enhance the taste of your dishes.

Home to Rome -Voyager



Diagnosed with bipolar disorder in 2017, Dan Keeley, has just completed his second gruelling challenge to raise awareness and money for Campaign Against Living Miserably. Teaming up with Swift Group, Dan ran from the London Eye to the Colosseum in Rome, raising over £10,000, which will fund over 1,250 potential life-saving responses via the CALM helpline and webchat services.

After struggling with his own mental health issues and receiving his bipolar disorder diagnosis, Dan wanted to share his story in the hopes of helping to normalise conversations around mental health, empower others to share their stories, battle stigma, and show that you can live your life to the fullest with support and professional guidance.

The charity that Dan fundraised for, Campaign Against Living Miserably, take a stand against suicide - providing advice, sharing stories, and operating a helpline for anyone that is struggling, online and over the phone, 365 days a year.

Back in 2017, Dan originally challenged himself with the reverse course - running from Rome to his home, London. On this first venture, Dan raised over £15,000 for the Campaign Against Living Miserably, and his efforts received national and international recognition.

Five years on and the adventure has evolved, with one key message at the core: the power of putting ourselves first. It's this message that Dan championed throughout his Home to Rome 1,150 mile challenge. In support of Home to Rome, Swift Group teamed up with Dan as his official Motorhome Partner, providing comfort on the road with a Voyager 584 for him and his family to use for the duration of the trip.



Dan kicked off his challenge from the London Eye, where he invited other runners to join him on the first day of this remarkable journey. Having averaged 35 miles per day over 35 days, Dan is the first and fastest person to have ever reached the Colosseum in Rome on foot

With the desire to support more, the portion of the trip that saw Dan cross the Alps, was dedicated to another charity close to Dan's heart, Snow Camp. Snow Camp utilise snow sports to bring about positive social change for young people through their life-changing snow sports programme. Originally aiming to raise a minimum of £2,000 for Snow Camp, Dan achieved his target of just over £2,100 for the charity.

Dan said "Through the challenges we've all faced over recent years, there's never been a more important time to connect to each other and ourselves, and to focus on our own sense of autonomy, well-being and passion for the things which light up our souls.

"The power of putting ourselves first means paying attention to the warning signs, shutting out the noise and truly listening to what's going on inside; finding the courage and confidence to do what you need to do to get back to the place you need to be and to live the life you truly want to lead.




